According to Howard, with properly tuned smoothing plane and use of cabinet scrapper, sanding is almost eliminated. After preparation of the wood, the program continued with demonstration of French Polishing. The club did manage to record the whole program on videotape, which should soon be available in the library. Owen did an excellent job recording this demo so the video will be quite instructional to all members.
