#### Left-Hander?

**Ken Patrick** got this from a friend in California, who is also a woodworker:

Sue got a discount coupon for one of <u>Amazon.com</u>'s new businesses, tools. \$30 off any online purchase of \$100 or more. I scanned the catalog looking to see if there was something I just had to have - for about \$100 (to maximize the percentage of the discount.) I was looking at the 7 1/4 inch circular saws and spotted a left-handed model by Porter Cable. They call it left-bladed - some right-handed folks prefer the blade on the left also.

It has a blade brake - a nice safety feature. It is also very light, only 10.5 lbs.

We ordered it - it arrived last week. I like it. My old saw is a heavy-duty Skill, 6 1/2 inch. It's hard to find replacement blades. It is also very heavy.

The model number for the left-bladed model is the reverse of model number of the right-bladed saw. 743 vs 347 - clever huh?


