Some reminders on Shop Safety

- Wear appropriate safety gear when operating a woodworking machine: safety glasses, face shield for extra protection, and hearing protectors or earplugs
- Make sure that workshop lighting and ventilation are adequate and that work surfaces are large and sturdy.
- Read your owner's manual carefully before operating any machine.
- Tie back long hair, roll up long sleeves and avoid loose-fitting clothing. Remove rings and other jewelry that can catch in moving parts.
- Keep children, onlookers and pets away from the work area.
- Never work when you are tired, stressed or have been drinking alcohol or using medications that induce drowsiness.
- Find a comfortable stance; avoid overreaching.
- Keep your work area clean and tidy; clutter can lead to accidents.


