Norm Shirk showed a wooden hinge he designed for use on a Boy Scout Chuck Box used for campouts. Norm employed an Incra Hinge maker to make the wooden piano hinge.

Wendell Wilkerson, a self-professed tool junkie, showed a WWII era Stanley #48 Tongue and Groove plane. The fence on the plane swivels from one side to the other to accommodate the cutting of either the tongue or the groove. Wendell explained that Japanning was used instead of nickel-plating because the nickel was needed for the war effort.

Steve Yauch showed a plant holder and the template he made when designing the piece.


