Has a cracked bedpost and wants some suggestions on how to fix it.

John Loftis

Two wagon wheels with 1 inch diameter bearing holes brought to him. Owner wants to have bearing holes enlarged to 1 1/2 inch diameter. The bearing holes are 7 inches long. John glued 1 inch diameter dowels into the holes to give himself something to center on. He then proceeded to cut the 1 1/2 inch holes. One turned out perfectly the other not quite so. It was suggested that John put a square box on top of the wheel bearing that he can use as a drill guide, to keep the drill perpendicular to the hole.

Turning a dark wood pen. When he finishes the wood, white specks under the finish become visible. He sanded the finish off and tried again with the same effect. Suggestions included removing the finish again and cleaning the wood with acetone and alcohol.
