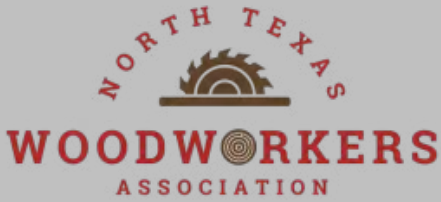

He crafted it with Spalted Maple and Walnut.

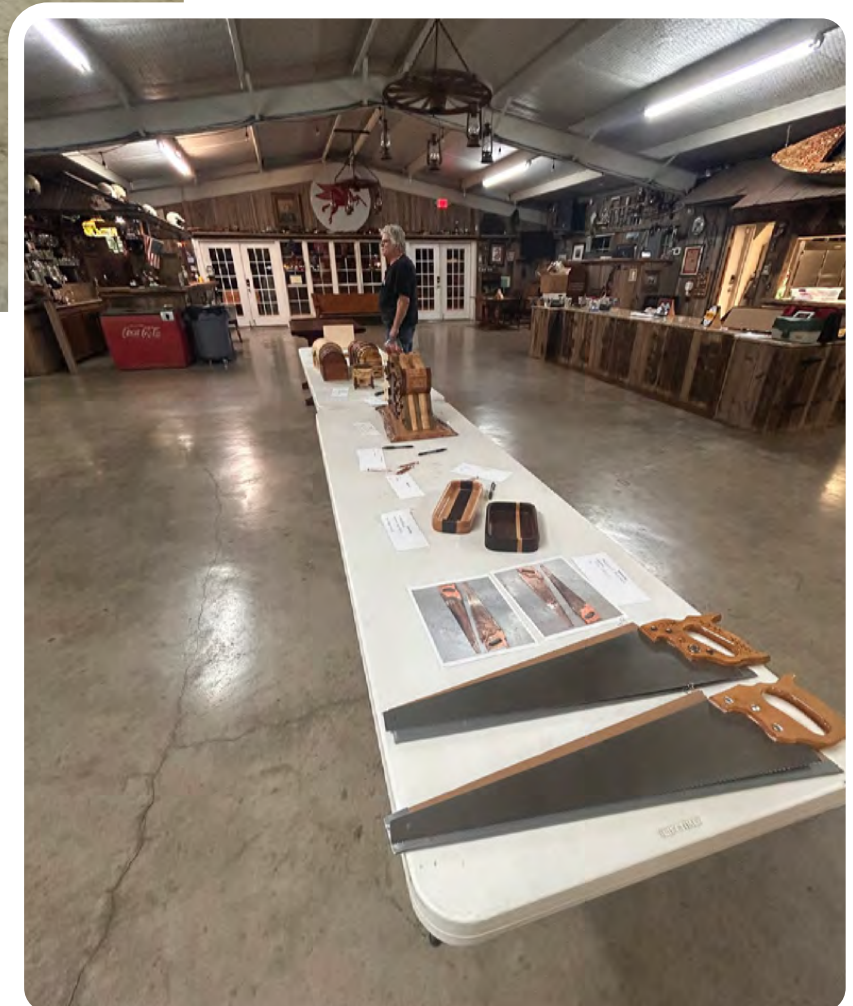
Ed Haluska made these 4 Boxes for the Beads of Courage Competition. He crafted these boxes using Cedar, Pine and Maple Wood!

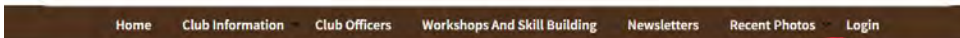

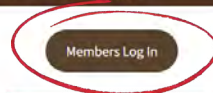


Woodworking In North Texas
